#### DOLE FOR PRESIDENT COMMITTEE

Served as Office Manager and general expediter of Senator Dole's campaign for the Presidency. Assisted in coordination of staff, routing and answering correspondence and surrogate speeches as a stand-in for the candidate.

#### NATIONAL TRANSPORTATION STUDY COMMISSION

This two year study was commissioned by the U.S. Congress to give the President and the Congress recommendations for transportation policy best designed to see America through the year 2000.

Handled liaison with Governors, Mayors and other local officials and some departments of the federal government. Assisted in drafting documents, correspondence and general information on the study recommendations.

#### DIRECTOR, BUREAU OF OUTDOOR RECREATION (BOR), DEPT OF INTERIOR

BOR is the banker for the \$300 million Land and Water Conservation Fund including Federal grant program to state and local government (60% of Fund) and Federal land acquisition program (40% of Fund). BOR is responsible for study and development of the national wild and scenic river program and the national recreational and scenic trails program.

## ADMINISTRATIVE ASSISTANT TO UNITED STATES SENATOR BOB DOLE

Administered staff personnel function for Senator Dole, including work assignments, recommendations for hiring, promotion, salary, and general oversight of all activities, including four Kansas offices located in Topeka, Kansas City, Parsons, and Wichita.

Handled liaison with all branches of the Executive Department regarding almost everything impacting on Kansas, including federal grants, contracts, appointments, and the entire range of constituent requests for information and assistance. Acted as representative to formal and informal meetings which Senator Dole could not attend. Prepared constituent mail replies for Senator Dole and handled telephone inquiries on his behalf.

## OEO DIVISION OF STATE AND LOCAL GOVERNMENT

Developed and assisted the Assistant Director for Operations in the development of policies for relating programs to state and local governments, and represented the Director of OEO and the Assistant Director in the implementation of such policies.

Represented OEO on intergovernmental task forces and committees dealing with matters at the operating level, often in conjunction with sub-cabinet agency heads and sub-cabinet level officials of the Federal departments, staff members of the President's and Vice President's offices, the Office of Management and Budget, Governors' and Mayors' offices, and representatives of the private sector.

## OFFICE OF LIEUTENANT GOVERNOR

Twice elected Lieutenant Governor of Kansas, serving once under a Republican Governor, William Avery, and once under the Democratic Governor, Bob Docking. Duties of the office included serving as President of the Kansas Senate, Chairman of the Kansas Legislative Council, Chairman of the Interstate Cooperation Commission, Chairman of the Motor Vehicle Reciprocity Commission, and a wide range of activities which fall under the general heading of "ceremonial".

## OFFICE OF STATE SENATOR

Served on the Assessment and Taxation Committee, the Insurance Committee, the Municipalities Committee, and the Education Committee. Identifier with greater state financial support for local elementary and secondary education. Strong advocate of prison reform, particularly as related to youthful offenders. Author of the first comprehensive small loan legislation that eventually became Kansas law. Worked effectively for legislation to improve the delivery of mental health services.

## NAVY RESERVE SERVICE

Enlisted in the United States Navy in 1942 and served on active duty both in World War II and throughout the Korean War. Remained in the Naval Reserve for 30 years, currently wearing the eagles of a Navy Captain.

## LECTURER FOR ASSOCIATED CLUBS

Four years Varsity debate in college plus wide career and travel experiences led naturally to many years service (part-time) with the "Associated Clubs" (Executive Clubs -- Knife and Fork Clubs).

Traveled behind the Iron Curtain twelve times, both as a private citizen and as a representative of the United States Government. Participated in a marathon three-hour interview with Nikita Khrushchev, and a two-hour interview with Anastas Mikoyan in the Russian Kremlin. Also interviewed the Prime Ministers of Romania and Czechoslovakia and top officials in Poland, Bulgaria, Hungary and Yugoslavia. In 1973, crossed Russia on the Trans-Siberian Railroad and interviewed Mr. Kravchenko, Chairman of the Siberian Council of Ministers, in Irkutsk.
